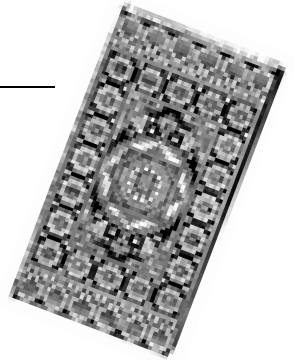


Lesson 14: Quiet and Loud Recitation

1. Introduction:

He (sal-Allaahu 'alayhe wa sallam) used to recite loudly in the morning prayer and in the first two rak'ahs of Maghrib and 'Ishaa', and quietly in Zuhr, 'Asr, the third rak'ah of Maghrib and the last two rak'ahs of Ishaa'. (PPD)
