Lowercase letters

Uppercase/Capital letters

-  The first letter in the alphabet is “a.”
-  The last letter of the alphabet is “z.”

THE VOWELS

A vowel is a
speech sound
made with the
vocal tract open

There are 5 vowels in the English language:

a e i o u

Every word must have at least one vowel.

Sometimes, “y” is a vowel too.
It is a vowel when it makes the sound of a vowel as in city (long e sound) and fly (long i sound),
